Description: Intermediate ICS expands on Basic ICS, but does not repeat Basic ICS. It provides more description and detail of the organization and operation of the ICS, management of resources, describes the duties of all positions including the Air Operations organization, and provides examples of how the essential principles are used in incident and event planning. One will construct an Incident Action Plan in a group setting related to an incident or event.
